APPLICATIONS are called for the UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND LAW SOCIETY MEDAL FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING GRADUATE OF THE YEAR 2009

- The most outstanding graduate will be selected by the Head of the Law School after consultation with the President of the University of Queensland Law Society.
- Eligible students are those who will graduate, or have graduated, in 2009 and who satisfy the following criteria:
 - (i) have an overall GPA of at least 6 in all completed LAWS courses;
 - (ii) have gained a grade of 7 in at least one LLB course at each level; and
 - (iii) have been positively and actively involved in –
 - (a) the life of the Law School or the Society; and
 - (b) the broader community; and
 - (iv) does not hold the office of the President of the University of Queensland Law Society.
- The award will be made to the applicant with the best overall performance in the criteria listed above.
- The value of the prize is \$1,000.00, a cast medal, and inscription on the honour board displayed in the Law Library.
- Applications for the award of the prize should be lodged with the Head of the Law School by no later than 5.00 pm on **4 December 2009**. Applications should be in the form of a letter addressing the criteria addressed to:
